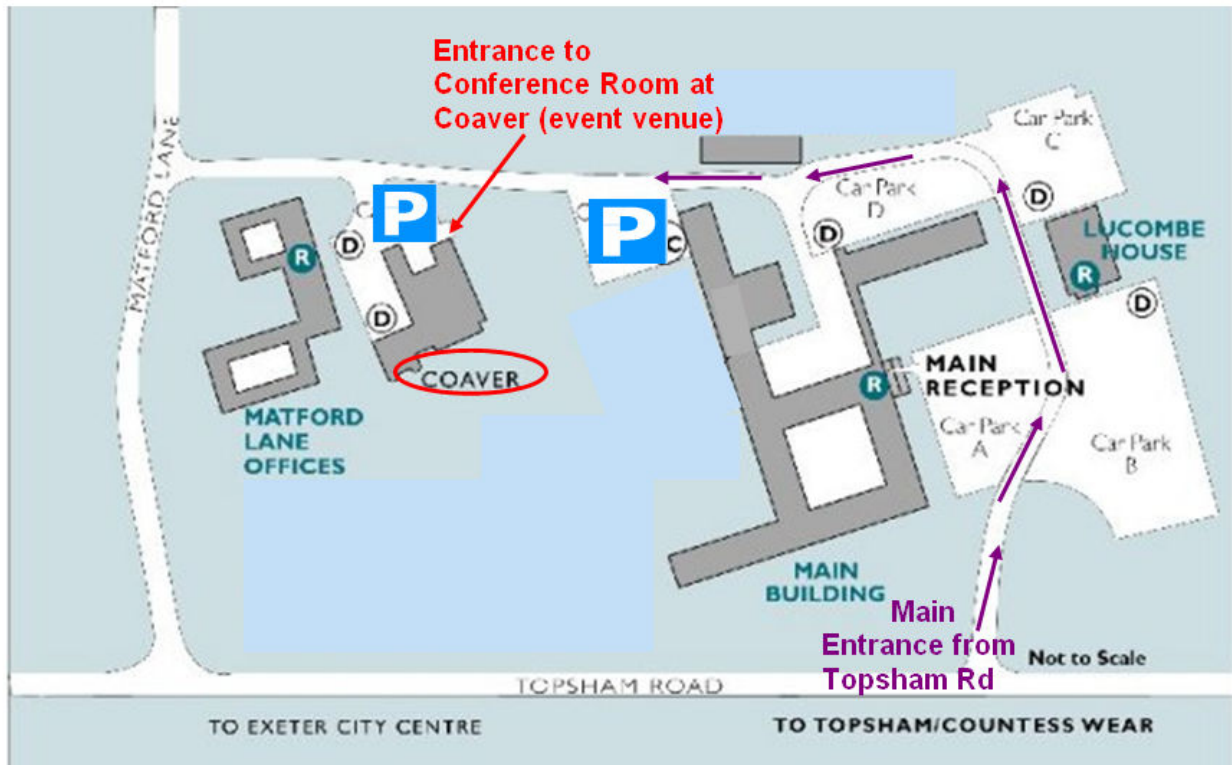


## The County Hall Campus



### Travel to County Hall EX2 4PS

#### Directions:

The meeting will be held in the Conference Room at Coaver Club at County Hall, off Topsham Road (for the Main Entrance), Exeter, EX2 4PS. Entrance to the Coaver Club will be restricted, so please look out for directional wall signs and follow instructions at the entrance door to gain entry.

#### Cars:

Before 3.30pm, parking is pay and display in the visitor car parks (Car Park A or B on the map). There is also on-street parking available in the area if these are full.

After 3.30pm, you are welcome to park free of charge in any of the staff car parks at County Hall. From the main entrance please drive through the car park barrier (which will be open), and follow the road around to the building as shown on the map above. The car parks marked

on the map with  are the closest.

#### Walking and cycling:

County Hall is a pleasant 20 minute walk from Exeter city centre. Exeter is also one of six national cycle demonstration towns and has an excellent network of dedicated cycle routes. Additional information can be found in the County Hall Travel Information document. Cycle stands are available outside County Hall Main Reception.

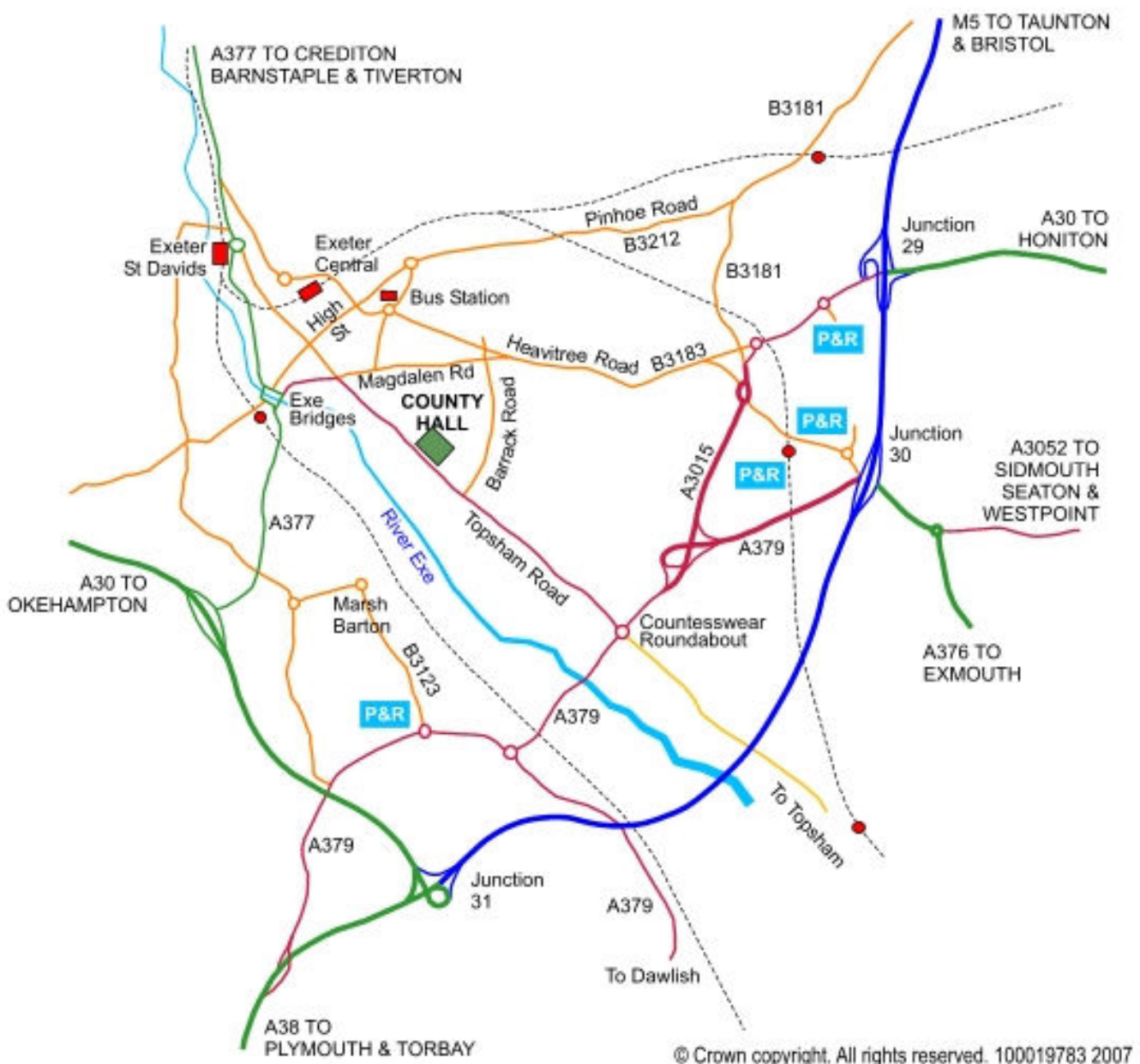

**Public transport links:**

Bus services J, K, S and T operate from the High Street to County Hall (Topsham Road). Local services to and from Dawlish, Teignmouth, Newton Abbot, Exmouth, Plymouth and Torbay all stop in Barrack Road, approximately five minutes walk from County Hall. Park and Ride services also operate from Sowton and Marsh Barton Industrial Estates with bus services direct to the High Street.

The nearest mainline railway stations are Exeter Central (five minutes' walk from the High Street) and St David's and St Thomas', all of which have regular bus services to the High Street.
